

Power Outages In Chippewa Hills

If one of our elementary schools has no power or another special situation such as no heat, gas leak, etc. when school opens in the morning, the following procedure will be used. If the power is scheduled to be back on prior to 9:00 AM students will not leave their home school. If other situations can be resolved before 9:00, students will not be moved to another elementary but may temporarily be taken to another safe location close to the school.

Every effort will be made to notify the radio and television stations that a school is without power. However there will be no announcement of a school closing unless the entire Chippewa Hills School District is closed or delayed.

In the event that there is no power in the secondary complex, the entire district will be closed for the day.

The following procedures will be in place.

No Power – Mecosta Elementary

Kindergarten, 1st and 2nd grades will go to Barryton
3rd and 4th grades will go to Weidman

No Power – Barryton Elementary

Kindergarten, 1st and 2nd grades will go to Mecosta
3rd and 4th grades will go to Weidman

No Power – Weidman Elementary

AM ECP, Kindergarten, 1st and 2nd grades will go to Mecosta
3rd and 4th grades will go to Barryton

There will be no preschool or afternoon ECP in the school with no power.

If the electricity comes back on in the morning or the situation is resolved and there is enough time to prepare lunch in the home school, students will be returned prior to lunch. If it is too close to lunchtime the students will eat lunch before being transported back. **In all cases, students will be returned to the home school prior to the end of the day, so that there will be no change as to how they usually get home either by bus or being picked up.**
