Turning the pages in order, touching the words, talking about pictures and talking about page numbers are all important skills as we learn to read. Thank you!



Our **Social Studies** focus is on TIME. Identifying- yesterday, today, and tomorrow. We have talked about all of the different ways we measure time --clocks, calendars, daily schedules...etc. Please take a moment to count how many clocks you have in your home and what kind of clocks they are.

### Learning Targets

I can name the colors pink, gray, & white.

I can name the letters of the alphabet and the sounds that they make.

I can rhyme.

I can count the letters in a word.

I can follow the text from left to right.

I can name the Season and tell about it.

I can retell the story "Chrysanthemum"

I can read my Decodable Readers "School" & "Go Play!"

I can tell about our theme "Off to School!"

I can write my name with a capital letter and small letters.

I can write some words or draw a picture about a topic.

I can count to 100 by ones. K.CC.1

I can write the numbers from 0-20, and write the numeral for the number of objects I counted.

K.CC.3

I can say the number as I count each object. K.CC.4

I understand that the last number I said is the total number of objects I counted. K.CC.4

I understand that each number name is one more than the last number name. K.CC.4

I can count objects to answer questions. K.CC.5

I can compare groups of objects to decide which is greater than, less than, or equal to. K.CC.6

I can compare two written numerals to decide which is greater than, less than, or equal to.
