## Reading:

I can read decodable story: "Edith and Pete"



## Math: I can learn addition and subtraction of length units

I can represent length with tape diagrams to represent and compare lengths

I can form base units of ten, a hundred and a thousand

I can count up and down between 100 and 220 using one and tens

I can count between 90 and 1000 using ones/tens
