Reading:

I can identify words with /e/ spelled ee, ea, e_e, e

I can learn the elements of an expository text:

I can learn the meaning of my vocabulary words

I can learn my spelling words

I can read my decodable story: “Meet the Bats”

Grammar: We are working on when to capitalize letters in sentences.

Writing: We are writing descriptive paragraphs about our Halloween costumes.



Math: I can learn place value, counting, and comparison of numbers to 1,000
