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Dear Parents,




Hello! We are now done with all of our testing. We have individual work and goals for each student. We work daily with each child by themselves and in small groups to move them toward the Kindergarten objectives. At times I will send things home for extra practice with you.

- Right now ---If your child does not know the letters and sounds of the alphabet I am asking you to practice this with them every day. Our curriculum moves fast and this is important! Thanks.



#### Learning Targets:

- I can name the letters of the alphabet and the sounds that they make.
- I can read the Kindergarten Sight Words.
- I can rhyme.
- I can count the words in a sentence.
- I can follow the text from left to right with my finger.
- I can name the Season and tell about it.
- I can read my Decodable Readers "The Tree" & "Flowers"
- I can tell about our theme "Patterns"
- I can see patterns in my surroundings.
- I can write my name with a capital letter and small letters.
- I can write some words or draw a picture about a topic.
- I can count to 100 by ones. K.CC.1
- I can write the numbers from 0-20, and write the numeral for the number of objects I counted. K.CC.3
- I can say the number as I count each object. K.CC.4
- I understand that the last number I said is the total number of objects I counted. K.CC.4
- I understand that each number name is one more than the last number name. K.CC.4
- I can count objects to answer questions. K.CC.5
- I can compare groups of objects to decide which is greater than, less than, or equal to. K.CC.6
- I can compare two written numerals to decide which is greater than, less than, or equal to. K.CC.7
